Asbestos is a widely used industrial material valued for its fire-resistant and insulating properties. Despite its benefits, inhaling asbestos fibres can cause serious illnesses and is linked to around 5,000 deaths annually in the UK.

This course introduces the nature of asbestos, its locations, and the associated health risks of exposure.
