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The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is a comprehensive data privacy law introduced by the European Union in 2018 to give individuals greater control over how their personal data is collected, used, and stored.

It applies to any organisation that processes data from EU citizens, regardless of the organisation's location. GDPR sets out strict principles for lawful data handling, including transparency, accountability, and security.
