Fire doors are vital for slowing the spread of fire and smoke, protecting escape routes and giving people time to evacuate safely. Their effectiveness relies on regular checks and proper maintenance.

It is a legal requirement to ensure fire doors are correctly installed and maintained so they remain fit for purpose. Under the Fire Safety Order, buildings must appoint a 'competent person' to help meet fire door regulations.
