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Children naturally seek fun and excitement, but their play can sometimes compromise safety or disrupt others, especially in busy environments. When staff intervene, supervising adults may react emotionally, even when the child is at fault.

This course equips team members with effective communication strategies to handle challenging situations tactfully, preventing escalation and maintaining a safe and welcoming atmosphere.

Module 1: Appropriate Behaviour

All team members, regardless of their role, must act when witnessing children behaving in a disruptive or dangerous manner.

- Encouraging good behaviour
- Maintaining a relaxed environment
- Expected behavioural standards
- Accountability for supervising children
- Consequences for persistent disruptive and poor behaviour

Module 2: Managing Situations

This module equips learners with the skills to assess situations quickly, communicate effectively, and collaborate with others to resolve issues in a positive manner.
