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Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is a core part of keeping your team safe when other controls can't fully remove a hazard. As a manager, you play a key role in ensuring the right PPE is selected, worn consistently, and used correctly.

UK law requires you to provide suitable PPE free of charge, ensure it's maintained and replaced when needed, and make sure your team is trained and confident in using it. Because PPE is the last line of defence, your oversight (checking fit, monitoring compliance, encouraging feedback, and modelling good practice) directly influences whether it prevents injury and illness on the job.
